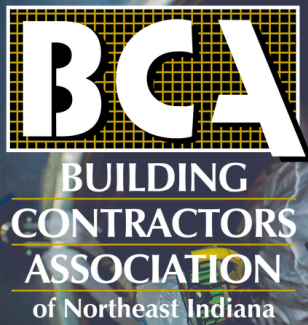

This training provides the knowledge needed to recognize confined spaces and work safely around them. Participants will learn how to identify and evaluate potential confined spaces, recognize the hazards associated with confined-space entry, and determine when a space meets the definition of a permit-required confined space.

The course covers employee and supervisor responsibilities, including hazard identification, communication, access control, and compliance with OSHA requirements.

Finally, the training will cover the site-specific confined space plan, rescue plan, and the process for notifying emergency responders in the event of a confined space emergency.
